




Step 1:


Lift-up the back end of the load first. You can use one or two jacks simultaneously.



Step 2:


Slide the rear dollies underneath the load, then lower it onto the dollies.





Step 3:

Now lift-up the other end of the load.



Step 4:

Slide the single dolly underneath.



Lower the load onto the dolly.




Step 5:

Now push the load.
The pulling handle can also be hooked to a forklift for towing.



If you have just one jack, lift the load directly next to the single front dolly.



You can also use
4 jacks
simultaneously
to lift-up all four
corners so you can
position all dollies at
the same time.
